### **If I have more than one child, do I need to fill out the blue PTA membership form more than once?**

Only one form is needed per family. Please put one student name and homeroom on the form in the student section so that PTA cards can be provided to you.

### **Which family members should join the PTA?**

It is up to you how many members of your family you would like to be members of the PTA. You are permitted to have all family members become PTA members but most people typically choose to have one or both parents become members. The first member costs \$10 and each additional member is \$5. As a member, you have a vote at General PTA meetings so having a parent as a member is a good idea.
