- Please use colored pencils, markers or crayons to design your dot on the original sheet provided. These will be fed into a scanner, so sheets that are warped because of paint, glitter, or objects glued or attached will not be used.

Color Combos by grade:

5th – Purple and Red

4th - Red and orange

3rd – Orange and Yellow

2nd - Yellow and Green

1st - Green and Blue

K - Blue and Purple
